## What is Alabaster?

+ A soft stone, which is translucent (lets light through) when cut thin enough.

+ When ground down, it can be used to make things like plaster, drywall, or chalk.

[41] "Two people owed money to a certain moneylender. One owed him five hundred denarii (1 day's wages), and the other fifty.

[42] "Neither of them had the money to pay him back, so he forgave the debts of both. Now which of them will love him more?"

[43] Simon replied, "I suppose the one who had the bigger debt forgiven."

"You have judged correctly," Jesus said.

+ What is **something of value** that you have **resisted giving** over to Jesus?

+ What is your **Most Valuable Possession**?

+ When is the last time you really just loved on God? Is your **loving** on God **comparable** to **the volume of the sins** for which you have been forgiven?
